Whisk the eggs in a pot.

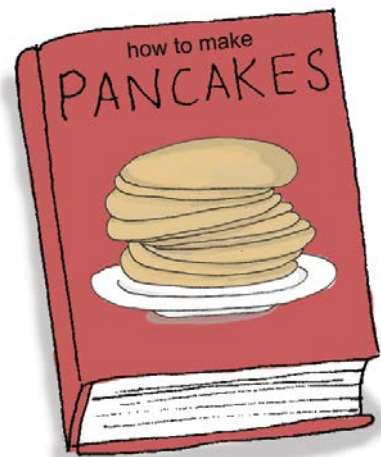
Add the flour and milk and mix it all up;
