## *Adventurers Classroom Code*


Be polite and respectful to people and property.

# Class Routines

School assemblies are organised online on Teams on Mondays and Fridays.

Good work e.g. writing shown on Mondays and put up in the classroom or school entrance. Certificates for high scorers with Class Dojo points given each Friday along with the star of the week for standing out in a positive way with behaviour, attitude, work etc.

# Class Routines

## Class Dojo

We use Class Dojo to award points for:

- Being kind
- Being respectful
- Showing resilience
- Staying safe
- Trying our best

We will also notify you if your child needs 'Thinking Time' or 'Time to Talk'. 'Thinking Time' is where your child needs some time to reflect on their behaviour within class. 'Time to Talk' includes time either with the Teacher or Family and Pupil Support Worker, usually outside the classroom, to regulate their behaviour.

# Class Routines

Our curriculum has been designed specifically to take into consideration the emotional and academic needs of our children on their return to school. Each day we complete lessons from the Bounce Back Programme which support the children through PSHE activities and discussions. Please see the website for more information.

We have also planned for greater cross curricular links by linking our English, Science and Humanities to one main theme in order to accommodate the additional time spent on PSHE. This enables us to consolidate the vocabulary needed within all lessons and opportunities to practise skills using the topic as a focus. This repetition will help to embed new learning.

# Homework

## Reading

It is expected that Year 5 read at home on a regular basis, ideally daily. As they become more responsible and independent, they should be able to read on their own but a little encouragement for them to do so (maybe before bedtime) might be a good thing. If you know your child struggles then we appreciate any support you are able to give them. Ask them about their book and help them to see reading as a regular, enjoyable activity (not work).

Children all have a school reading book but it will remain in school for the time being. Some children will have additional reading time with myself or Mrs Duffy to help them become more confident.

## Spelling

Spellings will usually be given out on a Monday (via class dojo) for a spelling test on Friday.

## Maths and English

More information will follow, but tasks are likely to be set via class dojo, the school website or teams.

Children still have a login for TT Rock Stars, and other maths games are available on Classroom Playground and Top Marks.

# Communication

Simple messages or queries can be sent to me via Class Dojo.

Admin related issues should be directed to the school office.

Children walking themselves home, or to a car etc. that might be out of sight, need to return a form. Some have done this already. If you can foresee an occasion when this may be required, please make sure you request a form to sign and return. Clear communication with your child will still be needed if going home arrangements change from day to day to avoid they walking if they are due to be met.
